









JONATHAN BARBER

New York City-based Jonathan Barber was voted the #1 Up-and-Coming Drummer of 2018 in Modern Drummer.

At the age of 30, he has already recorded and toured worldwide with such artists as Pat Metheny, Nicholas Payton, Buster Williams, Jeremy Pelt, Wallace Roney, Jennifer Holliday, Jimmy Greene, Harold Mabern, Steve Davis, Erykah Badu, Brooklyn Philharmonic and many more. In addition to his first-call status as a sideman, Barber has recently stepped forth as a composer and bandleader of 'Jonathan Barber & Vision Ahead'. He released his debut album entitled 'Vision Ahead' in 2018 followed by his sophomore album "Legacy Holder" in 2020. 'Legacy Holder' was received with high acclaim from the likes of Jazziz, Modern Drummer and Downbeat Magazine who gave the album a 4.5 star review.

In September 2019, Barber completed his first solo drum tour in Latin America (Mexico, Guatemala, Ecuador, Colombia, Argentina) and this was followed with a 5 city solo drum tour of China in December of the same year.

Barber now stands at the centre of a dynamic career that fuses music, education and fashion endeavours. Looking into the future he plans to continue this momentum by releasing more independent music, building partnerships and providing a platform and voice for the next generation of musicians.



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

Jonathan Barber & Vision Ahead Legacy Holder VISION AHEAD MUSIC

Jonathan Barber's star has been on the rise since his auspicious 2018 debut, Vision Ahead, and a 2019 tour in Pat Metheny's trio. The Hartford native's sophomore release, Legacy Holder, more than fulfills his promise, show-

The reflective title track highlights some fluid improvising by guitarist Andrew Renfroe and builds toward exhilarating heights through old-school trading of eights between pianist Taber Gable and pungent-toned altoist Godwin Louis. The runaway uptempo swinger "Major" is charged by Barber's forward momentum on the kit in tandem with Matt Dwonszyk's insistent walking bass lines. "Son Of Hartford" opens with Barber slamming against some angular arpeggiated unisons from Renfroe and Louis, recalling classic Mahavishnu Orchestra. If Barber is indeed a legacy holder, he's continuing in a lineage of adventurous drummer-composers spanning Tony Williams and Terri Lyne Carrington. There's an abundance of heightened energy and new ideas here, executed with pristine precision by the bandleader and his future-facing ensemble.

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


TAKING THE REINS

Jonathan Barber & Vision Ahead Legacy Holder

Thirty-year-old drummer/composer Jonathan Barber's previous album, Vision Ahead, was noticeable for its solid compositions and mature drumming. Legacy Holder strides further, with Barber's fusion-leaning compositions and arrangements equaling his kinetic drumming.

Multiple listens are required to grasp Legacy Holder's scope. Throughout,



Barber's full-set soloing concept and well-developed technique fills "Major"; he propels through-composed "29" with low-level, machine gun-like sticking (including a blistering, meter-twisting solo); apes heavy metal with the 4/4 swagger of "Son of Hartford"; and reveals compositional gifts with the Brazil-tinted "The Call." An album of subtlety and fire—more cerebral than stoner, more an inner world journey than an outward performance display—Legacy Holder retains its hypnotic spell for repeated plays. 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
